STEM Week begins today, and as part of our Science 2025 theme, "Adapt and Change", we've arranged for parents with a science background to lead exciting workshops for each year group. Additionally, every child across the school will be planting their own sunflower, taking part in fun, exciting challenges while recording the height of their sunflower.
