### **Year 6 Drawing Skills**

- 1. Experiment with different grades of pencil and other mediums.
- 2. Use sketchbooks to collect and record visual information from different artists.
- 3. Draw for a long period of time on their own.
- 4. Use different media to achieve variations in line, texture, tone, colour, shape and pattern
- 5. Plan, refine and change drawing when necessary.

#### Year 6 Painting skills

- Mix a variety of colours and know which primary colours make secondary colours.
- 2. Use a developed colour vocabulary.
- Experiment with different effects and textures including blocking in colour, washes, thickened paint.
- Work confidently on a range of scales e.g. think brushes on 4. small pictures.

- To be expressive and analytical to adapt, extend and justify their work.




Contemporary artist born in Nigeria but moved to America as an adult.

- Observational drawing- Drawing from observing, or looking at things in real life, rather than a printed image.
- Continuous line- A continuous line drawing is one in which a single unbroken line is used to develop an image.
- Tone- how light or dark a mark or colour is.
  - **Proportion-** How the sizes of different parts of a piece of art or design relate to each other.
- Shading- Drawing darker pencil marks show darker tones.

In this lesson, you will be completing the first stage of your final piece- the self-portrait.

- Tone- How light or dark a mark or colour is.
- **Shading-** Drawing darker pencil marks show darker
- Portrait- A photograph, painting or other artistic representation of a person, in which the face is always predominant.
- Cross-hatching- A type of shading that involves closely drawn parallel
- When planning, think about;
  - Proportion- size of different features of face
  - Scale- size of face
















In this lesson, you will be completing step 2 of your final piece- adding a vibrant background.

- Collage/mixed media- Using lots of different art materials to make one piece of art work.
  Tints- Adding white to make lighter shades.
- Tones- Adding black to make darker shades





- Explain choices made during the process, such as selection of colours and lines/marks made.
- Explain how the artwork is similar/different to Mike Barret's work.
- Say what worked well and what could be improved with explanations
