<p>SEND</p>	<p>Year 5 pupils who wish to take part in the 11 Plus in Autumn 2025 have the opportunity to apply for specific access arrangements if their child has SEND needs. The arrangements they can offer are for children to sit in smaller rooms, have extra time, breaks for medical reasons and coloured paper.</p> <p>Parents should follow the instructions given by the Local Authority for this, if they wish for their child to be considered. Parents will need to provide reports from professionals, which state the area of need and can also submit their child's support plans from school.</p> <p>The school may then be contacted to give further evidence.
