<b>Costings</b> The school receives £9000 in PE funding. This funding will contribute to the provision of the following curriculum services and resources:	
Premier Sports Partnership: Cost: £18000 – £19000 for academic year Summary: Premier Sports coaches will provide each class with one hour of specialist PE tuition each week. Coaches will also provide 8 Out of Hours School Clubs which will be free for children to attend.	
Golden Mile Path: Cost: £7000 - £8000 A pathway (approximately 80m) will be installed within the school grounds. This will provide children with an opportunity to carry out exercise on a daily basis and aim to walk a mile a day.	
Monitoring: All aspects of this spending plan will be monitored each term.
