#### **Whole School Attendance**

Whole School attendance has risen from 94.3% at the end of the Autumn term to 95.1%. Please help us to ensure this figure continues to rise by ensuring your child attends school whenever possible and by avoiding requests for authorised absence unless absolutely essential. Our current practice is to write to parents of any pupil whose attendance drops to below 92%. Any pupil whose attendance drops below 90% meets the government's threshold for a "persistent absentee".

#### Supporting Pupils with Reading

I recently wrote to you with information regarding improvements to our provision for reading in school. We regularly speak to children about reading and we have seen a noticeable increase in the number of children who tell us they enjoy reading and who are reading regularly at home. If your child is not already doing so, please encourage them to read for a short amount of time at home each day, and to ensure their reading records are completed and sent into school. Thank you for your support.

#### **Road Safety**

We have received reports from parents and local residents that the situation regarding parking and congestion on Norbury Avenue at pick-up and drop-off times has improved a little in recent weeks.
