Why should children learn this subject?

Science helps children to develop key life skills, including an ability to communicate, remain organised, focused and form their own opinions based on observations.

What will children learn to do in this subject?

At Brackenwood Junior School, children will:

- Acquire physics knowledge including forces and motion, light, sound, magnetism, electricity, Earth and space and energy.

- Providing children with the opportunity to meet various members of the STEM community.
