September Curriculum Meetings

Thank you to those of you who took part in our consultation on Sex and Relationships Education last term. We had 43 responses. I am pleased to report that 95% of responses said that they understood and agreed with the content of our SRE Curriculum. A number of parents have requested a little more information about the content being taught, and we will ensure this information reaches you prior to it being delivered to children in class. Just a reminder that our SRE curriculum is delivered through the Jigsaw scheme of work, and details of this can be found on the school website.

Daily Mindfulness Sessions

Each day begins with a mindfulness session from 8.45am to 9.00am. These sessions have the potential to dramatically improve the well-being and mental health of our children, and to ensure that they have a calm start to the day. Parents are invited to send in a colouring book or puzzle book for children to keep and use in school for these short sessions.

Music Lessons

Another benefit to the easing of Lockdown restrictions is that we are now able to reinstate music lessons. Learning a musical instrument carries many advantages and we would like as many children as possible to have this opportunity. Please look out for information coming your way soon about the range of instrumental lessons we will be able to offer.

Open Evening and Parent Consultations

We will be holding an Open Evening on Tuesday 12th October (3.45pm – 6pm). You are invited to come into school with your child to have a look around the building, speak to your child's teacher and look through your child's work. The evening will provide you with an opportunity to find out how well your child has settled into their new class, and how they are progressing with their work. There will also be individual parent consultations during the weeb beginning Monday 18th October for parents to have a more detailed conversation with their child's class teacher.

School Office

The school office can become extremely busy at any time during the school day, particularly when parents are picking up or dropping off. I would like to remind parents that we have Drop-Off Bins for forgotten PE kits or lunch boxes and a letter-box for handing in reply slips, letters etc. These can be found just inside the front entrance. When using either, please ensure that items are clearly labelled with your child's name and class.

Attendance and Absence

In an effort to ensure that low attendance does not present a barrier to learning for any of our children, and in order to maximise opportunities in regards to their achievement, we will be tracking children's attendance closely each day. Our aim is to ensure that as many children as possible achieve attendance of 97% or more. This means fewer than 6 days off during the academic year! Please help us to achieve this by getting your child into school whenever you can, and avoiding or minimising requests for authorised absence. Thank you.
