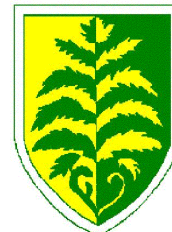

SUMMER TERM School Clubs

Dear Parents / Carers,

In Summer, we are once again offering a very wide range of extra-curricular activities. These clubs will be run by school staff, Premier Sports or by other private providers and full details of charges and how to sign up are given below. Please retain the timetable for future reference.

All clubs will begin the **week of Monday 25th April and run until Friday 15th July 2022.**

In line with DFE guidelines, children are allowed to attend clubs with children from different bubbles. Numbers will be strictly limited to 20.

Children will be expected to attend each week and will only be excused from a club with written parental permission. This is extremely important and co-operation from parents on this matter is much appreciated. Please presume that you have a place in the club, unless you hear otherwise (Via email from school)

How do I sign up?

Please complete the attached form **for all clubs** and send this back either via email to the school office or your child can hand it in to their class teacher before **Friday 1st April**. Please note, places are on a first come first serve basis.

Charges

There is a charge of £1.50 per session for all lunchtime clubs. There is a charge of £2.00 per session for all after school clubs. These should be paid via ParentPay before your child attends their first session. There is a charge of £3 per session for Drama club, payable weekly to the Drama coach. Please note that **payments are non-refundable**.

Behaviour

Behaviour in our school is exceptional and we expect the same high standard to be shown in all extra-curricular clubs. In order to achieve this, the traffic light system that is used in lessons will now also be used in all clubs. If a child is moved to red they will sit out for the remainder of that session and, during collection, the parent/carer will be informed. If a child is moved to red twice during the term they will no longer be allowed to attend the club for the duration of the term. Thank you for your support in this matter as it is important to Brackenwood Junior School that children show respect to all adults, and that the enjoyment of other pupils is not compromised. Please also note that if lunchtime sanctions have been issued to a child for bad behaviour on the day the child is due to attend a lunchtime club, the child will be unable to attend their club on that day.

Poor Weather

In the event of poor weather, sports clubs will still take place either in the Hall or a Classroom.

We hope that all the children make the most of the extra-curricular opportunities on offer. Our aim is to ensure that as many children as possible participate in at least one *active mind* and one *active body* club each week.
