English	<p><u>Reading</u> Children will be given a broad range of opportunity to practise and enhance reading skills including: Text familiarisation tasks Guided reading Reading Comprehension 1:1 reading opportunities</p> <p><u>Writing</u> The children will develop their writing skills through a range of genre. These include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Narrative• Explanation Texts• Description• Comparison• Evaluation <p>We will use a series of survival stories as stimulus for our writing this term.</p> <p><u>Speaking and Listening</u> Speaking and listening skills will be developed through class discussion, Leavers Assembly and opportunities to share and present work.</p>
Maths	<p>Each term children will be taught aspects of: Focus towards revision of topics for SAT preparation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Place value, ordering and rounding whole numbers and decimals• Sequencing and patterns, equations and algebra• Measures – length, area, perimeter, mass, capacity• Efficient written methods – $HTU \times U$, $TU \times TU$, $UT \times U$, $HTU \div U$• Efficient mental calculations• Problem solving using all 4 operations• Investigations, fractions, decimals and percentages• Shape – 2D & 3D shapes, position & direction, reflective symmetry, angles• Data handling within reasoning• Time/ calendar including problem solving• Transition maths ready for Y7
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This term, our Science units are: Light and Electricity – During this topic the children will have a chance to learn about shadows and reflection, through which, investigating that light travels in a straight line.• Electricity – This topic builds on the Year 4 work on electricity, taking it into the scientific use of symbols for the components in a circuit as well as considering the effect in more detail of changing components in a circuit. The children have the opportunity to apply their learning by creating an electronic game.
